When we left Romania on our last mission trip, we were troubled when we saw children suffering from malnutrition, infectious diseases, dental problems, and even lack of proper clothing for the cold winter months. Their condition broke our hearts and we wished we had more means to help all of them. Young adults are aging too fast because of poverty, overwork, and epidemic diseases.

There is great opportunity to honor the Lord in Oradea, Romania and show them that Americans care. In addition to the supplies and medicine that we bought to meet their needs, the Lord provided us with abundant donations of medical and dental supplies and equipment with a value of more than \$500,000 to establish a clinic in the new church building. For sure the Lord answered our prayers and we were able to ship a container the size of a large tractor-trailer truck in March so it would be there ahead of us when we arrived in June.



It was a blessing that we saw the Lord use our professions and ministry to spread His word among men and women of every age. We were blessed

to treat them, preach to them, pray with them, and praise the Lord together with them. Every morning before we start treatment we sing hymns, preach the Gospel. It was rewarding for us when we see the Lord used us to bring the lost to Christ. It is heartbreaking when you see these anemic helpless children suffering from parasites, malnutrition, as well as toothaches and losing their teeth at this early young age.

We went to several villages in the countryside to minister to people who do not have access to medical and dental treatment at all. They live on dirt roads and still use horses and wagons for transportation. Mrs. Lonnie Aucremann with her



wonderful patience and commitment to the Lord used her profession as a teacher to share with them the word of God. She made for them very interesting bracelets with different colored beads to explain to them the process of salvation through Jesus Christ, as He transformed us from our sinful, fallen nature to the righteousness through His blood. In fact, she vis-

ited some country schools and spoke to the classes, expressing to them the love of Christ and the care of the American people for them.

Not to mention, her husband, Stephen Aucremann, with his devotion and commitment to serve the Lord, he used his musical and vocal talent to minister to the teens and during the worship services.
